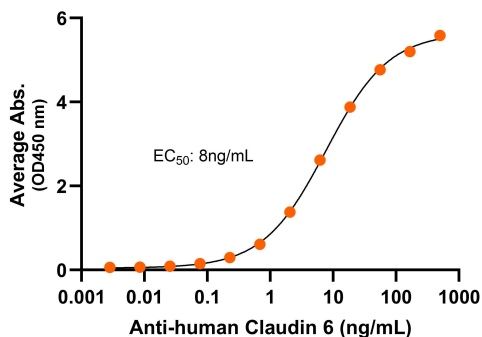


Bioactivity – Antibody Binding

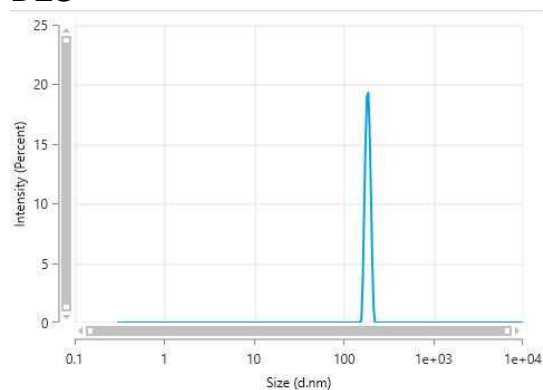
Human Claudin 6, ELISA

0.5µg of Claudin 6 per well



Immobilized human Claudin 6 VLP (Cat. No. CMP-24007) at 5 µg/mL (100 µL/well) can bind monoclonal anti-human Claudin 6 antibody with half maximal effective concentration (EC50) range of 6.6 - 26.3 ng/mL (QC tested).

DLS



The mean peak diameter (nm) of the CMP is 177.6 with a range of 162.9-196.6 with more than 95% intensity as determined by dynamic light scattering (DLS).

Background

Claudin 6, also known as Claudin-6 and CLDN6, is an integral membrane protein with 4 transmembrane domains, two extracellular loops, one intracellular loop, both N-terminus and C-terminus ends towards the cytosol. Human Claudin 6 is a member of Claudin protein family and is involved in tight junctions and cell-to-cell adhesion. It is highly and widely expressed on various tumor cells, and plays a critical role in cancer initiation and progression, and is a promising target for cancer therapeutics.
